

PLEASANT RIDGE COMMUNITY POOL

The following rules and regulations are designed to assure safe and sanitary operation of the Pleasant Ridge Community Pool and to comply with the State of Michigan regulations for public swimming pools. Parents are requested to emphasize to their children the importance of observing the rules and heeding the instruction of pool personnel. Please review these rules before visiting the pool.

All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the lifeguard office.

**The Pleasant Ridge Community Pool is a first come/first serve facility.
There may be times when the pool is operating at capacity,
and admission cannot not be guaranteed.**

ADMISSION

- The pool is open to persons who possess a valid membership ID card. The card must be presented by the pool patron each time they enter the pool.
- Children ages 7 and under and who can not swim the length of the pool by themselves, must be supervised in the pool by an adult or approved babysitter at least 15 years of age. Parents are responsible to watch their children at all times.
- Guests must be accompanied by a resident. The resident is responsible for the actions and conduct of his/her guests.
- Residents must remain in the pool complex while their guest(s) are visiting. When the resident leaves, the guest must also leave.

GENERAL RULES

- No person shall be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while in the facility. Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited within the facility.
- Smoking and use of smokeless tobacco is not permitted.
- Glass containers are not permitted.
- Animals of any kind are not permitted in the facility, except for working dogs.
- Abusive or inappropriate language will not be permitted at any time.
- NO RUNNING or ROUGH PLAY.
- Radios must be restricted to personal sound devices with headphones.
- The City of Pleasant Ridge is not responsible for personal property.
- Please secure items left in a locker with a lock. Items found on deck will be left at the office in the "lost and found." All lost and found will be donated to charity two weeks after it is lost.
- Guests with special needs are welcome; staff is pleased to provide assistance when requested.
- All aquatic personnel are responsible for the enforcement of all Michigan Department of Health "Public Swimming Pool Rules."
- All infants must be changed in the restrooms and swim diapers must be disposed of in the proper containers.
- The City of Pleasant Ridge reserves the right to limit admissions due to safety considerations.
- Admission to the pool may be refused to any person having a contagious, infectious condition or communicable disease; including open blisters, cuts, sores, wounds, etc. These guests will not be allowed in the pool.
- No skateboards, rollerblades/skates, or bikes are allowed inside of the Pool/Wellness center.
- Please direct any problems, concerns, or questions to the Manager in charge.
- Discipline is handled per basis, and can include warnings or dismissal from the pool for the day/season.

POOL RULES

- Only proper swim attire will be permitted in the pool enclosure. No jean shorts, under garments, t-shirts or cut-offs will be allowed due to health code violation.
- Rubber or plastic pants with elastic at the legs and waist must be worn over all diapers, with the exception of swim diapers.
- Showers are required before entering the pool or activity.
- Guests are responsible for providing their own towels.
- Parents and Guardians are responsible for their children.
- Parents (or a supervisor 15 years of age or older) must actively watch their children. This means that reading, lying down, talking or facing away from the child are not permitted any time the child is in the pool or on the deck.



- Spitting, spouting water, blowing of the nose or discharging bodily waste in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices are permitted in the pool. No Swimmies, water wings, floaties, rafts, body boards, or inflatable's are permitted in the pool. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices are permitted.
- No snorkeling or SCUBA equipment is allowed, including masks with a nose piece. Guests may use goggles.
- Diving is ONLY permitted off the diving board. NO FLIPS.
- Flipping, throwing, sitting on the shoulders, piggyback rides, and other unsafe activities are not permitted.
- Holding, standing or hanging on the pool lane lines, ladders, and rope is prohibited.
- Use only the designated pool entrance/exit.
- No food, gum or drinks are permitted in the pool. A designated area is provided where food and drinks must be consumed.
- Adult swim is the last 10 minutes of every hour. All patrons under the age of 16 must exit the entire pool.
- Discipline is handled per basis, and can included warnings or dismissal from the pool for the day/season.

Lifeguards have the right to stop any play which they deem dangerous. Guests must obey lifeguards instructions at all times. Please direct any problems, concerns, or questions to the manager in charge.

Diving Guidelines

- To avoid an injury, remember to dive straight off the board; do not dive to the side.
- Flips or back dives are not permitted off the board or side of the pool.
- After diving, swim straight to the side and exit the water.
- All dives are at the discretion of the staff.
- To ensure safe diving, only one person is allowed on the board and ladder at a time.
- Only one bounce is permitted on the diving board per dive.
- Children wearing approved flotation devices are not allowed to jump off the diving boards.

RESTROOMS/LOCKER ROOMS

- Eating, drinking or smoking will not be permitted in these areas.
- Loitering is prohibited.
- Lockers may be used on a single visit basis only.
- Patrons using the facility must shower and enter the pool through the provided entrance through the showers.
- Patrons may not occupy a locker over night.
- The City of Pleasant Ridge and its staff are not responsible for any items which are lost, damaged, stolen, and left in the lockers or pool area.

WEATHER/CLOSING POLICIES

- **Thunder/Lightning:** The pool will be cleared immediately. Patrons must leave the pool deck area. The pool will remain closed for 30 minutes after each occurrence of thunder/lightning.
- **Severe Weather:** The facility will close in the event of a severe weather warning (tornado watch/warning or thunder storm warning). Patrons will be asked to leave or take shelter depending on the severity of the storm.
- **Cold Weather/Rain:** If the air temperature is below 70 degrees, steady rain, or the total attendance is fewer than 20 people in a two hour period, the pool will close. If the pool closes during general swim, it may re-open at the discretion of the management. Please call before returning to the pool.
- **Contamination:** The pool will be cleared in the event of contamination. The closing period is dictated by the extent of the contamination. The Management staff will determine the length of time required.
- **Swim Meets:** The pool will close at 4:00 for all evening swim meets. (June 18, July 8, and July 12 2010, Synchro Dates are Aug 17, 18)

The City of Pleasant Ridge staff reserve the right to restrict any activity and/or use of equipment that may be deemed as dangerous. The staff also reserves the right to restrict use to any person who is misusing or disrupting said activity or equipment.

All Residents must re-activate the Pool Pass for the 2010 season. Valid proof of residency (Driver's License) is required. All pictures will be updated.

2010 Fee Schedule for the Community Pool

Membership

One issued to every resident in the City.

*“A Member is a resident of the City of Pleasant Ridge.”
Must have a valid driver’s license or State ID*

Guest Pass

One pass issued to every household upon request that allows a Member to bring 35 individual guests during the swimming season (1 guest = 1 use). No fee for this pass. This card expires after 35 guests have used the card or at the end of the pool season (visits do not carryover to the next year on this pass).

Additional Guest Pass will be available to purchase at a cost of \$10.00 each or increments of 10. Unused visits on this card may be carried over to the following pool season.

“A Guest is a non-resident, adult or child. A guest must be accompanied by a resident in order to have access to the pool facility.”

Caregiver Pass

One issued by address upon request by a resident member.
FEE **\$150.00**

“A Caregiver is a non-resident adult (16 years of age or older) engaged by a resident to care for or attend the needs of a member of the household. A Caregiver must be accompanied by a resident in order to have access to the pool facility.”

Pass Plus

One issued by address upon request by a resident member.
FEE **\$150.00**

“The Pass Plus Card allows the resident one guest per visit. The guest does not have to be the same person every visit and member must be present with the guest.”

Commercial Property Owner

One Membership and one Guest Pass available to owner of the commercial property.

“A Commercial Property Owner is a person who owns commercial property in the City of Pleasant Ridge. The Owner of the property will be issued a Membership Card and one Guest Pass. Commercial Property Owners will not be allowed to purchase additional Guest Passes. Guests must be accompanied by Owner (member).

Non-Resident Taxpayers in the City of Ferndale:

Residents who live on Oakridge in the City of Ferndale that own property in the City of Pleasant Ridge will be allowed to purchase a Membership and Guest Passes to the Pleasant Ridge Pool. The cost for a Membership Pass will be based on the taxable value of the property multiplied by the current millage rate for the pool. For example, a house with a taxable value of \$100,000 on the portion of land in Ferndale and a taxable value of \$10,000 on the portion of land in Pleasant Ridge would pay \$276.10 for the 2009 pool season.

$$\begin{array}{rcl} 2.27 \text{ mils} \times \$100,000 & = & \$ 227.00 \\ 2.27 \text{ mils} \times \$ 10,000 & = & \$ 22.70 \\ \text{total} & = & \$ 249.70 \end{array}$$

City Employees – Community Pool Department

One card per employee NO FEE

Employees of the Community Pool are lifeguards, swim team instructors, front desk, etc. These employees will be offered an Individual Employee Membership to the Community Pool for unlimited personal use of the pool facility. The Employee Membership will be issued to one individual and will not include Guest privileges (only the employee will be allowed access to the pool).

Swim Team Participants

An individual membership will be offered to a non-resident Swim Team participant.

\$150.00/first card issued
\$100.00/each additional card
(i.e., siblings that are on the swim team)

All non-resident members of the Pleasant Ridge Swim Team will be offered an Individual Pool Membership that allows that person access to the Pool at all times during the pool season. This membership is restricted to the individual and will not include Guest privileges (only the swim team participant will be allowed access to the Pool). The fee for an Individual Pool Membership does not include the fee to participate on the Swim Team.

Residential Rental Property

Membership Pass and Guest Pass issued to tenants of the rental property.

“Membership is issued to the property. The tenants of the rental property are residents of the City and will be entitled to membership. Tenants must possess a valid driver’s license or State identification card.”
